1. Opening comments and introductions of tele-conference participants
2. Discussion of our TTI Final testing report for FDOT (to be posted within the next couple of months) that included our Hot Weather testing and testing of the 24" Pexco CityPost Express Lane Markers
 - Finished 36in. and 24in. back in October
 - Waiting on FDOT director to finish edits and submit back to TTI
 - Once edits are finalized, Paul can speak more publically about the results.
 - Based off TexDOT study, 3 different categories
3. Discussion on the revised TTCD Project Work Plan and how it evolved from the previous work plan to the new AASHTO test method 17-02
 - TTI and Paul did most of the work on this item
 - Has major updates and much more in depth testing available
 - Submission cycle opens next month (4.2.18), Fee sheet is available on ntpc.org website
 - Would like to eventually have other devices available for evaluations
 - Need to determine what states want to see moving forward in order to incorporate appropriate products

- Will allow us to hone the Work Plan to be more effective and useful for manufacturers and states
 - **If you go to the annual meeting, make sure to reach out to Paul while there to discuss the needs in your state**
4. Discussion of how this will impact the other states as far as what their “Delineator” specifications and standards mandate.
- MASH is unsure how it is going to handle Type 1 devices
 - There is not much discussion being had about what to do with these devices
 - The requirements in the NTPEP Work Plan is exceeding the current MASH requirements
 - ***AI: Paul will provide survey questions to Jonathan to have them sent out to states to see what they want***
